Blind C is a unique programming competition where you have to write the program in c language for the given problem with the monitor kept off. Problem statement will be given on the spot to the participants.

Purpose:

This activity mainly tests your concentration, accuracy and programming skills.

Rules & Regulations:

- 1) Each participant has to write the code for given problem, with MONITOR OFF.
- 2) Participants whose code gets executed will be given higher preference.
- 3) The second preference will be given to code with least number of errors.
- 4) In case of tie in number of errors, TIME of SUBMISSION will be considered.
- 5) This is an individual event. The compiler provided will be Turbo-C.
- 6) Pretest will be conducted in MCQs format you have to clear that test then only you will be appear for Round-1.
- 7) This event consists of 2 rounds.

Round-1 contains 2 “C” Programs of medium complexity.

Round-2 contains 2 “C” Programs of high complexity.

- 8) Shortlisted participants of Round -1 will appear for Round-2 for which above rules are applicable.
